

Beachrings² Comparison to Beach Access Wheelchair (Beach Wheelchair)

Beachrings² Benefits:

- All-Terrain – sand, shallow snow, soft soils, mud, gravel
- Portable
- Flexible to conform to land and man-made contours
- Reusable, long-lasting, UV protection added
- Easy to install, clean and maintain
- Inexpensive
- Multiple uses – wheelchairs, pedestrians, strollers, vehicles, canes and walkers
- Cool surface for pedestrians
- Rolls up for storage – compact storage
- Expandable – modular units are easily configured
- Color variety

Beachrings² Drawbacks:

- Subject to theft – theft prevention measures may be needed
- Access is limited to where the Beachrings² mats are located

Beach Wheelchair Benefits:

- All-Terrain – sand, shallow snow, soft soils, mud, gravel
- Mobility – not constrained to path or paved area
- Most are high quality and long-lasting

Beach Wheelchair Drawbacks:

- Expensive - \$1200 to \$3600 per chair
- Public rental infrastructure needed - employees and equipment, insurance
- Large storage facility needed for multiple units
- Only one concurrent user per wheelchair
- Regular maintenance needed on most models
- Specialized service needed for motorized and manual models
