

# Grasspave<sup>2</sup> vs Geoweb

Presto Products, who manufacture “Geoblock” and “Geoweb” have continuously tried to overturn projects specified with our Grasspave<sup>2</sup> product since they became licensed to sell the “web” product by the US Army Corps of Engineers several years ago. They have done this because both of their “Geoblock” products are more expensive than ours and perform less effectively in traffic conditions.

We feel it is very important to make sure that you are aware of the performance characteristics, maintenance, and safety issues that distinguish our Grasspave<sup>2</sup> from “Geoweb”, and other similar web confinement products on the market.

Our Grasspave<sup>2</sup> offers:

- solid traffic bearing surface capability,
- true micro scale soil/root zone confinement and protection
- true root zone compaction resistance from traffic
- easy ability to topdress, reseed, skin built up sod (when buildup too thick)
- no soft product walls that fold over and become tripping hazards
- a product designed for grass paving, not just base stabilization
- a true grass paver at the lowest cost to purchase and install

The other major factor for comparison is installation time of these products. According to an experienced contractor in Florida, who has experience with all three products - Grasspave<sup>2</sup>, Geoblock and Geoweb. In a phone conversation, he related that Geoblock takes twice as long to install as Grasspave<sup>2</sup>, and Geoweb is even more difficult and time demanding than Geoblock.

When you compare the performance as well as the relative ease of installation, our Grasspave<sup>2</sup> product should be the product of choice.
